April 13th *Wild about Wildflowers* - Join the Clermont County Park District and the Little Miami Conservancy for a walk on the wildflower side! Learn the secrets of wildflowers during our hike through Nesbitt Park, Make a seed bomb to take home and release. Story time featuring “The Tiniest Seed” By Eric Carle.

May 11th – *Mammal Madness* – Coyotes, Foxes and Deer, oh my! Animals have many adaptations that help them survive in their habitat. Can you think of some adaptations that help humans survive? Learn how to identify some of our favorite local animals by their adaptations and by searching for animal “clues” during our outdoor hike, make your very own “tracks” to take home and join in on a fun game.
